Speaking of the monthly meetings, you may have noticed that the venue has been..... fluid.....this year. It seems that once we get settled in a new spot, the place closes. We have had one meeting now at our new location in Richmond Hill. Let's hope that we don't have to go looking for a new spot again for a while.
